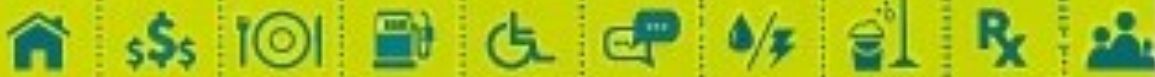

Contact Us

Reach out to a librarian or staff member at the Grosse Pointe Public Library for a private and confidential conversation about your medical issue and needs.

We Search the Database

Based on your unique situation, the librarian will search through Deno's Database to find foundations that offer resources specific to your needs.

The database includes resources and organizations that are not typically found through the average internet search.

3

Apply and Connect with Resources

Once the search is complete, the librarian will gather, print and provide you with the necessary forms to fill out to connect with the appropriate foundations and resources. Simply complete the forms and submit them directly to the organizations. Shortly after, you'll start hearing back and collecting resources from foundations that are able to help.
